Dear Parents/Carers,

I can hardly believe that we have reached the end of our first half-term. The children have settled in beautifully to their new year groups and both Nursery and Reception have quickly settled into school life.

Premises update and buildings work

With the increase in demand for school dinners due to the universal infant free school meals, there is a requirement for the current school kitchen to be expanded. We envisage the work to commence after half term, and will last a number of weeks. The work can progress safely during term time, however, as the car park will be affected, the gates at the back of the premises will need to be locked (this procedure will be in place after half-term). We recommend that if you have siblings, you drop/collect the eldest first at the start and end of the day via the KS2 playground and walk back via the front of school if you need to enter the KS1 playground.

We hope all children who are entitled to Universal Infant Free school meals have taken up the offer. Please see the office if you have any questions. For children in Juniors taking school meals the cost for the half-term is £71.75—this must be paid online in advance. Please encourage Junior children to bring a piece of fruit as a snack for break time.

Children who do not attend Handsworth should only be on Handsworth Premises if collecting a younger sibling, not to accompany a friend or meet a parent. Thank you for reinforcing this as we are trying to reduce unnecessary congestion within the playgrounds.
