The total cost for this trip is £315. If you would like to pay this amount in instalments, we have a suggested payment schedule with a deposit of £65, with 6 further payments of around £35 and a final payment of £40 over the course of 7 months. Please see ParentPay for the payment schedule.

If your child is eligible and registered for Free School Meals, we are able to subsidise educational visits, including residential trips, through Pupil Premium funds. Please contact the office to speak to me to discuss this further.
