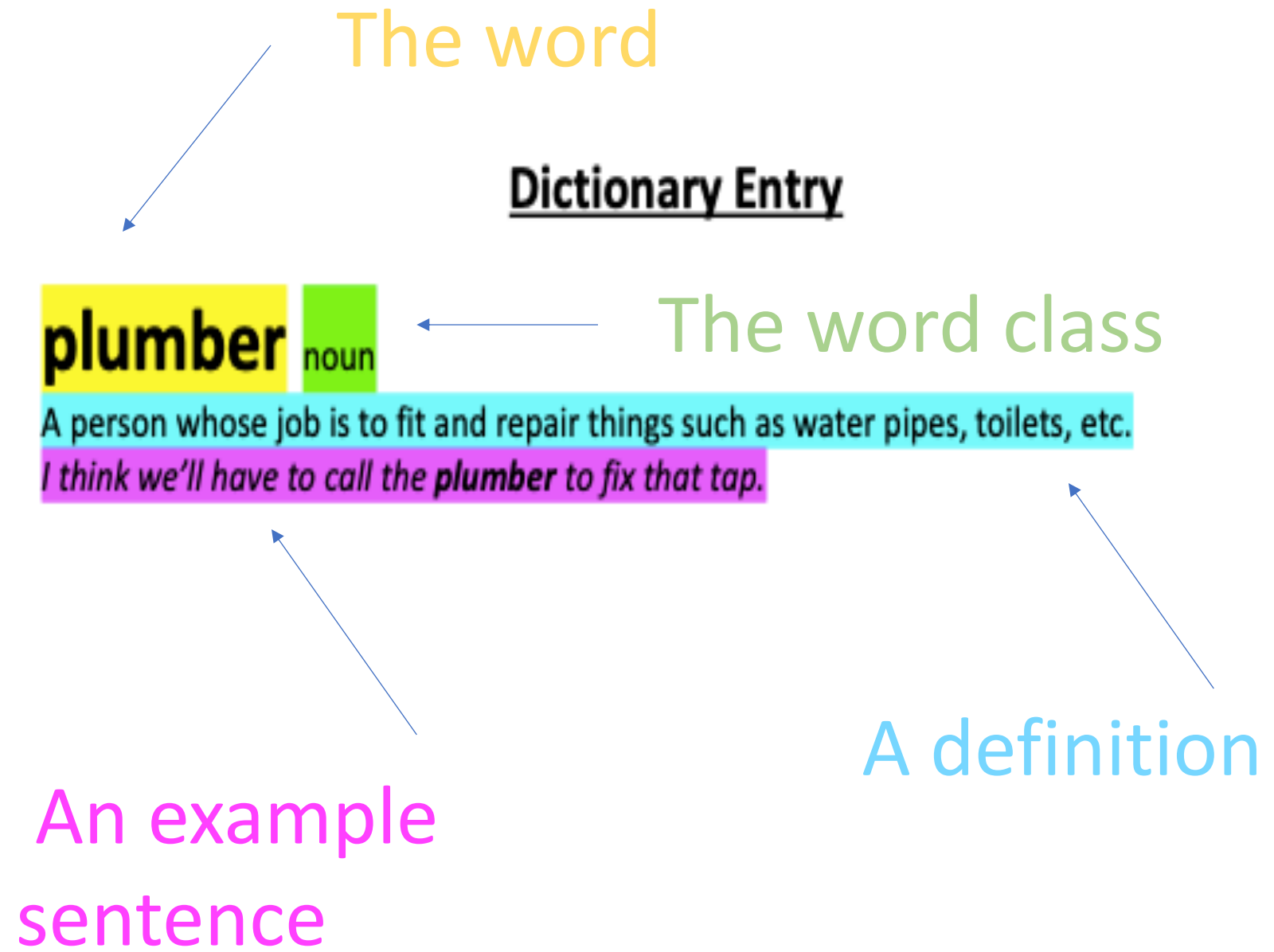

## Dictionary Entry

**plumber** noun

A person whose job is to fit and repair things such as water pipes, toilets, etc.

*I think we'll have to call the **plumber** to fix that tap.*

**wooden** adjective

To be made of wood.

*The karts were **wooden**.*

**fast** adverb

To move quickly.

*She drove **fast** in her kart.*

**fast** adjective

Moving or capable of moving at high speed.

*He won as he had a **fast** bike while my car was too slow.*

Some words  
belong to more  
than one word  
class!

### Multiple word classes

Look at how Mario and Luigi are using the word 'click'.



I heard a loud  
**click**.

noun

I will **click** my  
fingers loudly.

verb



Are they the same word class?

No! One is a verb and the  
other is a noun.

### Multiple word classes

What about the word 'hard'?



This is a super  
**hard** piece of  
cheese!

adjective

I find swimming  
very **hard** to do.

adverb



Are they the same word class?

No! One is an adverb and the  
other is an adjective.
