


Joining to the Letter 'f'

Remember that \mathbf{f}' is an unjoined letter so we never join from it, but we can join to it. Practise these diagonal joins to the letter \mathbf{f}' :



Add the 'ef' letter pattern to these words. Your 'e' can join on to your ' \mathbf{f} ', but remember that you don't join on from your ' \mathbf{f} '.



Add either 'af' or 'if' to these words. Join carefully to your 'f' but don't join on from it. What words have you created?
