3 Award 1 mark for answers that provide an appropriate definition of what *the sole survivor* means in this context, e.g:

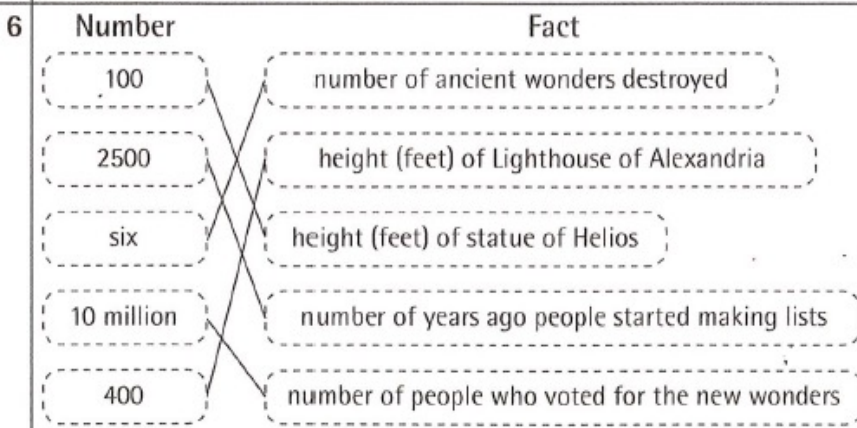
- The only one/the only monument left
