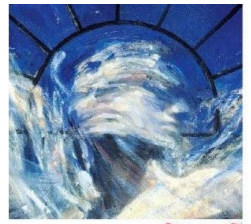

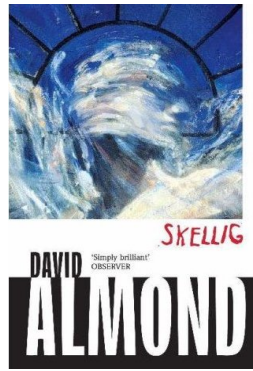

Or **PEE.**

# LO: Analyse a text



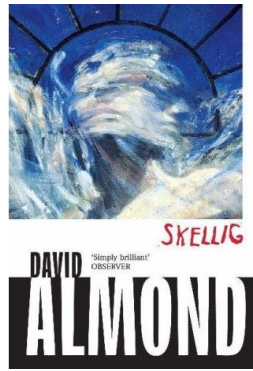
Using **PEE** is easy:

**Point:** State your main idea or opinion in simple terms.

**Evidence:** Use a quote from the text to prove or support what you are saying.

**Explain:** Examine the writer's word choice or the character's actions or behaviour in more detail. You can give your opinion here too.

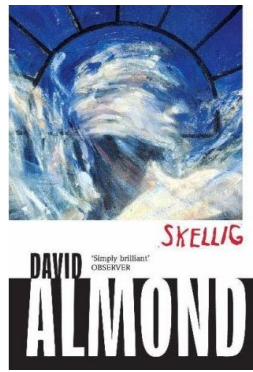
Look at this quote from Skellig.

**“The red sauce trickled down from his lips, down over his chin on to his black jacket.”**

*What do you think it tells us about the creature?*

- a) He was hungry.
- b) He had no table manners.

a) He was hungry.

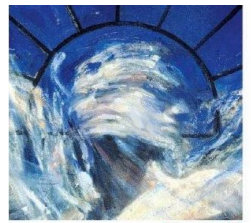
Point

We know that Skellig was hungry because it says in the book: “The red sauce trickled down from his lips, down over his chin on to his black jacket.” (Page 27) This shows that he is in a rush to get food as he hasn’t eaten for a long time.

We know that Skellig had no table manners because it says in the book: “The red sauce

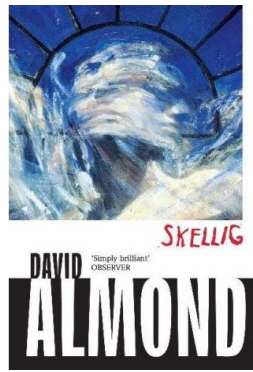

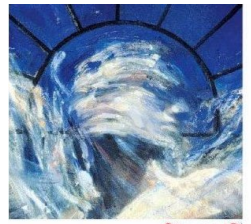


What do you think this quote tells us about Michael?

Point

Michael thinks that the creature smells awful.

Evidence

We know this because it says in the book: "I tried not to breathe, not to smell him." (Page 29).

Explain

It shows that Michael is a kind boy. He wants to help the creature and he doesn't want to hurt his feelings so he tries to hide the fact that he smells.
