Handsworth Primary School is committed to supporting good attendance for all pupils. We understand that the last couple of years have been difficult for everyone, and we have tried to be as supportive as possible. It has been hard to travel and see family, to make doctor and dentist appointments out of school time, and we have had to be vigilant for covid symptoms before sending children to school.

We thank you for following the rules and helping us keep our community safe. We now need your support in raising attendance levels. Children must have good attendance to get the most out of their school experience.

Please remember :

Try not to book doctor/dentist appointments during the school day.

If your child has an appointment, please bring them to school before and/or after the appointment.

Inform the office of any appointments and show/send in an appointment card or letter or a copy of the text confirmation.

If using the online form, please state what type of appointment it is and the reason and bring in/email a card or letter after the appointment or when collecting your child.

Please fill in this form if you need to take time off from school. As a school, we can not authorise any holiday during school time.

The school register is taken at 8.50 am. If you arrive after this time, you are marked as late.

If your child is ill, please phone or email the school to let us know, on each day of the absence, before 9 am. If we can not get in touch with you, it will be classed as an unauthorised absence

If you use the online form to report an absence, please state the type of absence and a reason

Your child will need 48 hours off after vomiting or diarrhoea

If necessary, the school office can administer medication, so please bring it to the office to be signed in if needed.



Remember children are resilient and with encouragement from home, can come to school with a little tummy ache or the sniffles and still have a great day! If your child is reluctant to attend for any reason, please talk to the class teacher so we can offer support as soon as possible.

If you have any questions or concerns, please get in touch as we would like to work with you to support your child in attending after a prolonged disrupted period.

Our whole school attendance for this academic year is 94.7%, but this could be higher. Let's work together to improve our attendance!
