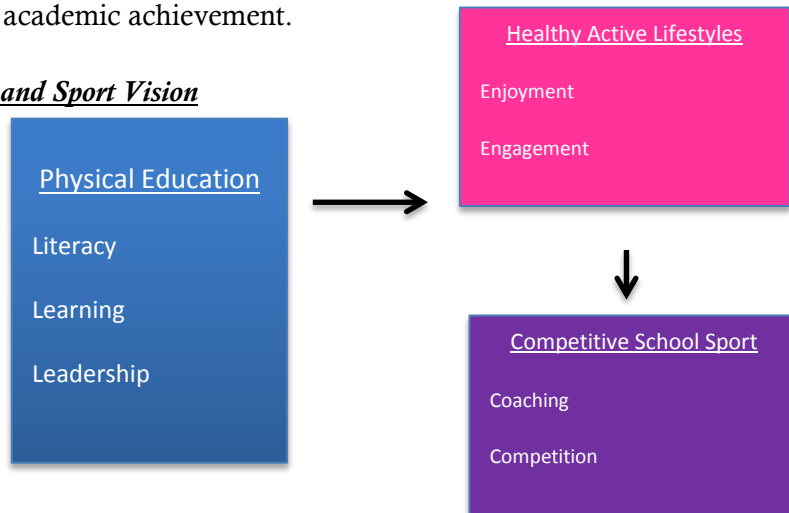


Sports Premium Overview

What is the Sports Premium?

The Government is providing funding of £150 million per annum for academic years 2013/14 and 2014/15. This funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, with money going directly to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. In 2014/15, Handsworth received £9,800.

Purpose of funding

Schools have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport and they have the freedom to choose how they do this.

How we intend to spend our allocation

- Improving our curriculum delivery through relationship with WFSSN (Waltham Forest School Sports Network), CPD training and new resources.
- Skilled coaches in curriculum areas offering wide ranging activities with opportunities for enrichment in after school clubs (dance, gymnastics, team sports, athletics).
- Ensuring all children have the opportunity of extra-curricular clubs by offering Pupil Premium children free places.
- Enhanced equipment to enable excellent delivery of clubs, lessons, training and competition.
- Providing an appropriate and broad range of competitive sports and experiences for all ages and abilities.

How we spent this academic year's allocation

- New sports kit
- Increased competition participation enabled with cover supply for PE subject leader
- CPD training enabled with cover supply for PE subject leader
- 5-a-day upgraded to use at home
- Athletics coaching for years 2-6
- Specialist Dance Teacher

How it made a difference to PE and sport participation

- Sports kit has increased children's identity with their school and its community while also enhancing the pride they have in representing the school.
- Allowing all children to access clubs and physical opportunities.
- Increased motivation and enjoyment in sport.
- Increased opportunity to try new sports (hockey, tag rugby, netball, hockey).
- Further opportunity to compete and achieve (swimming, cross country).
- Opportunity to build relationships with peers (football, hockey).
- More confident and competent staff
- Positive impact on whole school environment
- Sport update assemblies to promote the achievements and opportunities
- Maintain children's positive attitudes to PE
- Maintained high level of pupil participation

In addition we have swimming for Year 4 in the Autumn Term, coaches to deliver curriculum and after school sessions and are a member of the WFSSN (Waltham Forest School Sports Network) which helps support our P.E delivery while also offering CPD opportunities and competitions for a range of ages and abilities. The Sports Premium is allocated along with additional curriculum funding for P.E in order to up skill, resource and further improve the provision at Handsworth.
